





Rip has only one bad point: he doesn't like working. He only does the things he likes. He sits on a rock and fishes all day. He walks in the forest and



Rip is unhappy and confused. "I am alone in a strange world and no one knows me. Does anyone know Rip Van Winkle?" he cries.




